TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:

The attention of all prospective bidders on the above project is directed to the following additions and modifications to the Contract Provisions and Contract Plans.

I. ADDITIONS, MODIFICATIONS, AND/OR DELETIONS TO THE PROPOSAL

ITEM 1:

Page P-2, Proposal

DELETE the Proposal (pages P-1R through P-9R, Addendum 2) in its entirety and **REPLACE** with the attached Proposal (pages P-1R through P-9R). **Changes include:**

- 1. Add the following bid items (numbers shown are based on attached proposal):**
 - a. Schedule B, Bid Item 30, Manhole Removal and Wastehaul.**
 - b. Schedule B, Bid Item 31, 12-Inch Gravity Sewer Main Removal and Wastehaul**
 - c. Schedule B, Bid Item 32, Temporary Bypass Pumping**

2. **Revise the following bid items (numbers shown are based on attached proposal):**
 - a. **Schedule B, Revise the Title of Bid Item 12 from “HMA Cl. 1/2" PG 58H-22” to “HMA Cl. 1/2" PG 64H-28”**

II. ADDITIONS, MODIFICATIONS, AND/OR DELETIONS TO THE TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

ITEM 1:

Page 01110-5 Specification Section 01110-1.5 B., SCHEDULE B – COLLECTION SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

ADD the following to the end of this section:

- “10. The work on the collection system shall be continuous. Once the Contractor commences work, it shall be continuous until fully complete. The collection system work shall be complete by August 14, 2020.”

ITEM 2:

Page 01200-9 Specification Section 01200-1.4, Measurement and Payment

REVISE Item No. 12 (added text is italicized, deleted text is shown as strike out):

- “12. HMA Cl. 1/2" PG *64H-28* ~~58H-22~~.”

ITEM 3:

Page 01200-13 Specification Section 01200-1.4 C., SCHEDULE B: COLLECTION SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

ADD the following to the end of this section:

- “30. Manhole Removal and Wastehaul
 - a. Measurement: Will be measured per each.
 - b. Payment: The unit price per each for MANHOLE REMOVAL AND WASTEHAUL shall include all costs for furnishing the labor, material and equipment necessary to remove and wastehaul existing manholes, and filling voids with bankrun gravel, as shown on the Plans and as specified herein.
31. 12-In. Gravity Sewer Main Removal and Wastehaul
 - a. Measurement: Will be measured per linear foot.
 - b. Payment: The unit price per linear foot for 12-IN. GRAVITY SEWER MAIN REMOVAL shall include all

costs for furnishing the labor, material and equipment necessary to remove and wastehaul existing 12-inch diameter gravity sewer main, and filling voids with native material, as shown on the Plans and as specified herein.

32. Temporary Bypass Pumping
 - a. Measurement: Will be measured by lump sum.
 - b. The lump sum contract price for TEMPORARY BYPASS PUMPING shall include all costs for labor, materials, and equipment required to maintain existing sewage flows entering the existing gravity sewer system and bypassing the flows around the construction, as shown on the Plans and as specified herein. Progress payments for this item shall be made to the approximate percentage of the total project complete at the time the progress estimate is prepared.”

ITEM 4:

Page 02740-1 Specification Section 02740-2.1, HOT MIX ASPHALT PAVEMENT

REVISE the first sentence of Section A. (added text is italicized, deleted text is shown as strike out):

“Hot mix asphalt pavement, HMA Cl. 1/2" PG-58H-22 64H-28, shall conform to Section 5-04.2 of the WSDOT Standard Specifications.”

II. ADDITIONS, MODIFICATIONS, AND/OR DELETIONS TO THE CONTRACT PLANS

ITEM 1:

SCHEDULE A, SHEET G-5, NEW WWTF PIPING PLAN

North of Clarifier No. 1, **ADD** the following callout at the 2" NPW pipe:

“Contractor shall install two buried water isolation valves. Waterlines are anticipated to be 3-feet deep 2-inch galvanized, exact location shall be determined in the field. Valves shall be ball valves installed in a valve box per Detail 6, Sheet GD-2.”

ITEM 2:

SCHEDULE B, SHEET GD-4, RESTORATION DETAILS

Detail 2, **REVISE** Note 3 (added text is italicized, deleted text is shown as strike out):

“ALL HMA SHALL BE HMA CLASS 1/2" PG-58H-22 64H-28.”

ITEM 3:

SCHEDULE B, SHEET C-1, SITE PLAN AND PROFILE STA 0+00 – 3+00

At Manhole No. 5 9, **ADD** the following callout:

“Contractor shall contact BNSF rail master (Nathan Hendricks, nathan.hendricks@bnsf.com) to move rail racks. BNSF will move the racks; Contractor shall coordinate and schedule at no additional cost to the Owner.”

The undersigned agrees that in the event it is Awarded the contract for the Work, it shall employ only Contractors and Subcontractors that are duly licensed by the State of Washington and remain so at all times they are in any way involved with the Work.

It is anticipated this project is funded in part by the Washington State Department of Ecology. Neither the State of Washington nor any of its departments or employees are, or shall be, a party to any contract or any subcontract resulting from this solicitation for bids.

The undersigned agrees that the Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals and to waive any minor irregularities and informalities in any Proposal.

The undersigned agrees that the Owner reserves the right to Award the Contract to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder whose Proposal is in the best interest of the Owner. Additive Items will be determined at the time of award.
