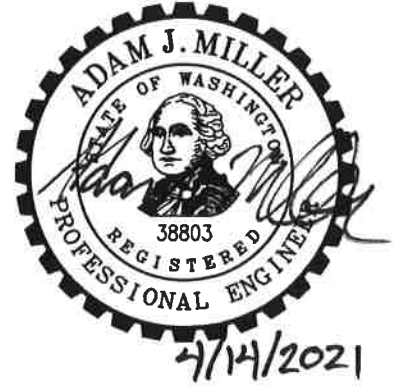

TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:

The attention of all prospective bidders on the above project is directed to the following additions and modifications to the Contract Provisions and Contract Plans.

I. ADDITIONS, MODIFICATIONS, AND/OR DELETIONS TO THE PROPOSAL

ITEM 1:

DELETE the Proposal (pages P-1R through P-11R (Addendum 1)) in its entirety and **REPLACE** with the attached Proposal (pages P-1R through P-11R).

Changes include:

- 1. Adding the following bid items (numbers shown are based on attached proposal):**
 - a. Schedule A, Bid Item 27, Side Sewer Connection, Open Cut**
 - b. Schedule A, Bid Item 28, Side Sewer Connection, Existing Main**
 - c. Schedule A, Bid Item 31, Side Sewer Connection, Pipe Burst**
 - d. Schedule B, Bid Item 19, Side Sewer Connection, Pipe Burst**

II. ADDITIONS, MODIFICATIONS, AND/OR DELETIONS TO THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS

ITEM 1:

Page 7-24, Special Provisions Section 7-18.4, Measurement

ADD the following after the second paragraph:

“Side Sewer Connection, Open Cut will be measured per each.

Side Sewer Connection, Existing Main will be measured per each.”

ITEM 2:

Page 7-25, Special Provisions Section 7-18.5, Payment

In the eleventh line of the second paragraph, **DELETE** “connections to existing and new systems” and **REPLACE** it with the following:

“connection to existing side sewer”

ITEM 3:

Page 7-25, Special Provisions Section 7-18.5, Payment

ADD the following after the second paragraph:

““Side Sewer Connection, Open Cut,” per each.

The unit contract price per each for “Side Sewer Connection, Open Cut” shall constitute full compensation for all labor, materials, tools, equipment, transportation, supplies, and incidentals required to connect new PVC side sewer to new PVC sanitary sewer main, to include, but not be limited to, dewatering, excavation, backfill and compaction, remove and waste haul of surplus excavated materials, furnishing the services of a Contracting Agency approved testing laboratory to conduct compaction testing, tees, wyes, pipe spools, adapters, connectors, and flexible couplings as required for a complete installation.

“Side Sewer Connection, Existing Main,” per each.

The unit contract price per each for “Side Sewer Connection, Existing Main” shall constitute full compensation for all labor, materials, tools, equipment, transportation, supplies, and incidentals required to connect new PVC side sewer to existing sanitary sewer main, to include, but not be limited to, dewatering, excavation, backfill and compaction, remove and waste haul of surplus excavated materials, furnishing the services of a Contracting Agency approved testing laboratory to conduct compaction testing, saddles, wyes, tees, pipe spools, adapters, connectors, and flexible couplings as required for a complete installation.”

ITEM 4:

Page 7-33, Special Provisions Section 7-22.4, Measurement

ADD the following after the second paragraph:

“Side Sewer Connection, Pipe Burst will be measured per each.”

ITEM 5:

Page 7-34, Special Provisions Section 7-22.5, Payment

ADD the following after the second paragraph:

““Side Sewer Connection, Pipe Burst,” per each.

The unit contract price per each for “Side Sewer Connection, Pipe Burst” shall constitute full compensation for all labor, materials, tools, equipment, transportation, supplies, and incidentals required to connect new PVC side sewer to new HDPE sanitary sewer main, to include, but not be limited to, dewatering, excavation, backfill and compaction, remove and waste haul of surplus excavated materials, furnishing the services of a Contracting Agency approved testing laboratory to conduct compaction testing, tees, saddles, wyes, pipe spools, adapters, connectors, and flexible couplings as required for a complete installation.”

After the date and hour set for submitting the Proposals, no bidder may withdraw its Proposal, unless the Award of the contract is delayed for a period exceeding 60 consecutive calendar days.

The undersigned agrees that in the event it is Awarded the contract for the Work, it shall employ only Contractors and Subcontractors that are duly licensed by the State of Washington and remain so at all times they are in any way involved with the Work.

The undersigned agrees that the Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals and to waive any minor irregularities and informalities in any Proposal.

The undersigned agrees that the Owner reserves the right to Award the Contract to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder whose Proposal is in the best interest of the Owner. The Owner will determine at the time of Award of the Contract whether Additive Schedule B will be included in the Contract.
